Course Title: Chinese 5/6 and 7/8
 Prerequisite(s): Chinese 1/2 and 3/4
 Grade Level(s): Grades 11-12

Course Objectives:

Students functioning within this Level can understand and learn language related to daily settings. Can use more complex grammatical structures and sentence patterns to communicate on familiar topics through interaction and description. Can compose passages. Demonstrate confidence and interest in learning the Chinese language. Have some knowledge of learning strategies, communicative strategies and resource strategies. Have gained Chinese cultural knowledge and acquired preliminary cross-cultural awareness and international perspective.
